




Feedback Form- Architectural Design IV


How much did you enjoy the Architectural Design IV class? 1 is least and 5 is most.






How much did you enjoy the teaching in the class? 1 is least and 5 is most.


Very caring teaching staff and admin staff. Helped me alot in b.arch and are helping me out after b.arch as well. Really thankfully to all the staff and to ASAD.
